## *Exhibition Factoids*

The ATL Central Atrium Gallery space is (15) 4' x 8' wall panels. Panels are joined in groups of 4 around the 4 columns that support the Atrium ceiling.

Exhibitions consist of two image pairings per panel. A four image exhibition will consist of two adjoining wall panels. The six image exhibition will comprise three adjoining wall panels. Image orientation may be either horizontal or vertical.

All frames are identical in size (23" x 27") and style. Image media size not to exceed 16" x 20". Image size must allow for boundary on media for matting.

Exhibition prints are produced and owned by artist. Artists pays a \$20 per image matting fee. Framing and matting are provided by APG. Airport provides installation services. APG & the Juror reserve the right to reject any submitted print that is not deemed to be of sufficient quality.
